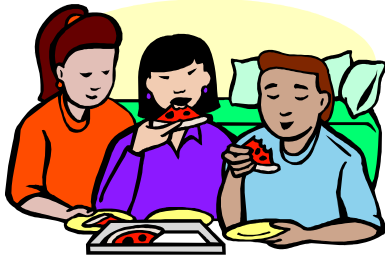


Friends, Culture, and Risky Behavior
