Join us for a special two-part series on **Understanding Attention Deficit Disorders – What We Know, and What We Can Do**. In this two-part series, Dr. Ethan Schafer, Lawrence School psychologist and Director of the Lawrence Assessment Center, will be presenting the work and research of internationally-recognized ADHD authority, **Russell Barkley, PhD**.
